

Public Opinion Data on Black Lives Matter Police Reform

Combined crosstabs: weeks of June 12 & 19, 2020

Beginning 6/12, Civis has asked a series of weekly survey questions about support for Black Lives Matter, and understanding of/attitudes towards police reform. Below you can find combined cross-tabulations from the first two weeks of data.

Survey data was collected from approximately 2,200 US adults age 18+ each week, and responses are weighted to be representative of the larger adult population.
